- Develop strategies for appropriate treatment with an interprofessional team.
- Implement appropriate treatment for AFE, which may include delivery to facilitate resuscitation and for newborn survival.
- Develop strategies to implement use of POC ultrasound in practice to provide enhanced care for pregnant patients.
- Demonstrate the ways in which POC ultrasound can be used at the bedside for the pregnant patient.
- Determine risk factors for shoulder dystocia.
- Perform the appropriate technical maneuvers to manage a shoulder dystocia emergency.
- Determine the causes and stages of postpartum hemorrhage.
- Develop appropriate strategies for the prevention and treatment of hemorrhage.
- Implement a care management plan to avoid hemodynamic decompensation and ensure rapid response to postpartum hemorrhage.
